



The **Charleston Soccer League** was established in 1979 and provides three levels of play opportunities for youth throughout central Illinois in grades pre-k through 12.

At the **Pre-academy level**, children in pre-k through 2nd grade learn the essential skills of the sport under the direction of Mark Hansen. Hansen, a graduate student in Sports Administration at Eastern Illinois University and volunteer assistant coach for EIU, was a four-year starter at Eastern and has coached for CSL for four years. As director, he advises players from Eastern men's and women's soccer teams who serve as coaches, working with area youth in structured lessons throughout the 6-week session.

At the **Academy level**, also under the direction of Mark Hansen, parents have the opportunity to coach and play **recreational games** with area youth in grades 3 through 8. Games are all played locally.

At the **Competitive level**, area youth try out for traveling teams. For more than 20 years, these teams have successfully competed (previously as Panther Soccer Club) in varying age-divisions throughout central Illinois. In 2008, the league established CFC (Charleston Football Club) as it's competitive division, replacing Panther Soccer Club. Dino Raso, assistant coach for Eastern Illinois University men's soccer, facilitates as director of coaching. Raso also holds a U.S. Soccer Federation A License and employs both Eastern men's and women's soccer players, as well as qualified and/or licensed coaches, as the individual teams' coaches. Teams also play in select tournaments throughout the year.

Charleston Soccer League is now accepting registration for its Fall 2009 pre-academy skills training program.

**Pre-K and kindergarten participants will meet with their designated coaches on Mondays from 5-6 p.m.**

**First and Second grade participants will meet on Mondays from 6:15-7:15 p.m.**

Sessions typically begin with stretching and basic foot skills with coach Hansen. Participants are then divided into "teams" and work with individual coaches, in groups of six to eight, on foot skills, passing skills and kicking skills. Toward the end of each session, participants play mini games to practice what they've learned. At the end of the six-week program, participants are recognized and awarded for their achievements.

**A special festival day** is scheduled at Eastern Illinois University's Lakeside Soccer field following an EIU soccer double-header:

Come out, watch the games, support your coaches and stick around for fun and activities with EIU Men's head coach and former Pre-Academy director, Adam Howarth.

Finally, if you can, join fellow players and coaches on Monday, Oct. 26 as Eastern's Mens' Soccer take on Asbury College. Gametime is at 3 p.m. CFC pre-academy players will be recognized at half time and will have an opportunity to play on the field.
